### **PURPOSE**:

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA:**

- 1. Applicant must be a graduating senior currently enrolled in a school district in the Northwest Region of the Ohio School Boards Association, and have plans to major in teacher education at an accredited college or university in the state of Ohio.
- 2. Applicant must have a 3.00 or greater grade point average (GPA).
- 3. Applicant must demonstrate potential as an educational leader, professional competence, community involvement, and evidence of good moral character.

#### **SELECTION PROCESS:**

- Applicants in the Northwest Region of the Ohio School Boards Association will be responsible for forwarding their applications and transcript for consideration for the Ohio School Boards Association Book Grant Awards, postmarked by <u>Friday</u>, <u>March 14</u>, <u>2014</u>.
- 2. The Northwest Region, OSBA Book Grant Award Committee will review all applications and will contact the winners in May. Recipients will be recognized at the annual conference held in October.

# Northwest Region Ohio School Boards Association Educational Book Grants

To be **eligible** for the Book Grants, **applicants must**:

- 1. Plan to major in teacher education at an accredited college or university in the state of Ohio.
- 2. Possess a minimum of a **3.00** or greater grade point average (GPA).
- 3. Demonstrate potential as an educational leader, as evidenced through the submission of:
  - a. A one-page essay describing:
    - Your future plans and intended major, including what college/university you plan to attend
    - Why you want to be a teacher
    - What contributions you would like to make as an educational leader
  - b. A minimum of <u>two letters of recommendation</u>, one from an <u>academic teacher</u> and one from a <u>community</u> <u>member</u>. (Coaches and counselors are eligible only for *additional* support unless they have served in an academic capacity)
  - c. A <u>listing</u> of your participation in leadership positions, extra-curricular activities, and community involvement
  - d. A current transcript

All applications <u>not</u> accompanied by the supporting documentation described above or applications received after the due date will be <u>ineligible</u> for consideration.
