

Colonel Crawford Academic Boosters Scholarship 2016

The Colonel Crawford Academic Boosters are offering **three** \$500 scholarships to senior students at Colonel Crawford High School who are intent on pursuing a post secondary education in a two or four year accredited college or university.

Any student with a 3.0 G.P.A. or higher (verified by the Guidance Counselor) is eligible to apply. Financial need will not be a factor in the committee's decision. The applications will be evaluated on a 40-point scale with 30 points assigned to the essay and 10 points for school activities and community service.

Applications must be returned to the Guidance Counselor in the CCHS office by March 25, 2016. Do not attach a transcript.

The Colonel Crawford Academic Boosters Scholarship Chairperson will select three judges to review each application. After all applications are evaluated, the top three recipients will be selected. The scholarship recipients will be notified for the first time at the CCHS Academic Awards night. No checks will be given at the Awards night, but a check will be made payable to the college or university that the student plans to attend when the first tuition payment is due. It is the student's responsibility to contact the Booster's treasurer or president with his or her college information.
