Things to bring:

- *Social Security number*
- *Driver's License*
- *FSAID (see below)*
- *Income tax records for 2016*
- *Investment information/current bank statement*

You can request your FSA ID number at this web site: <https://fsaid.ed.gov>. The FSA ID will be a username and password.

The student must have an FSA ID and one parent must have one. Both the parent and the student must have unique e-mail accounts. You can request these numbers early so that you are ready to electronically sign and file the FAFSA.

Although limited computers will be available at the library, you may wish to bring your own laptop.

Whether you need a few questions answered or line by line assistance completing the form, a college expert will help you complete the FAFSA.
