Criteria: For the Huber Family Scholarship

- 1) Preference should be given to those choosing a career in education or fields closely related.
- 2) Student should have a GPA of 2.75 or above. Special attention should be given to the last three years.
- 3) Student should show evidence of a variety of extra-curricular activities. (sports, music, the arts, jobs after school & during summer vacation, etc...)
- 4) Community service should also be a serious factor.
- 5) Special consideration should be given to "financial need". This can be shown by attaching a copy of the SAR or a brief summary your means of paying for college.
- 6) Application must be returned to Ms. Kelbley by May 1.
