

BUCYRUS KIWANIS CLUB **ACADEMIC and TECHNICAL** **SCHOLARSHIPS**

The Kiwanis Club of Bucyrus, Ohio will awarding one scholarship of \$1500.00 to academic scholarship and two scholarships of \$750.00 to a technical school (one being North Central State College Bucyrus branch) to students who will be attending accredited schools.

Kahle-Wenner Scholarship of \$1000.00 will be awarded in the fields of study of Computer Science, forestry or Medicine. Both Academic and Technical applicants are eligible.

ELIGIBILITY

Graduating Seniors of Bucyrus, Colonel Crawford, Wayside Christian, and Wynford schools are eligible to receive these scholarship awards provided they have been a bona fide student of the aforementioned schools for at least two (2) years preceding graduation. Only those students who enter four year or more degree programs for the first year are eligible for academic scholarships and those entering 2 year degree or technical schools are eligible to receive the technical scholarships. Kahle-Wenner applicants must be planning to study Computer Science, forestry or Medicine and can be applying for academic or technical programs.

APPLICATION

Application should be made through the school counselor's offices not later than, Wednesday **April 8, 2015.**

SELECTION

These scholarships will be awarded on the basis of evidence of likelihood of successful completion of the applicant's course. Considerations will include academic standing, achievement in courses related to proposed field of study, character, personality, leadership, co-curricular activities as well as any other qualities deemed worthy of emulation by their peers. Financial need will be considered but will not be an exclusive criterion.

The Bucyrus Kiwanis Club Scholarship Committee will select the scholarship recipients.

CHOICE OF SCHOOL

The scholarship is limited to schools accredited by the Ohio Department of Education. Correspondence schools are not eligible.

FINANCIAL PROVISIONS

The award of **\$1500.00 academic scholarship, \$750 for 2 technical scholarship and \$1000.00 for and Kahle-Wenner** will be paid by the Bucyrus Kiwanis Club Treasurer directly to the schools selected by the individuals to whom the scholarships shall be given and are to be applied to tuition, books, and study materials and fees.

OTHER PROVISIONS

Since the Bucyrus Kiwanis Club is a community service organization whose income from year to year is never certain, there can be no guarantee that these scholarships will be available every year. However, it is the present intent of the Club's Directors to continue the awards each year (1) if the necessary funds are available, (2) if worthy students make application for these scholarships and (3) if it seems to serve a worthwhile purpose. While these scholarships are in the form of an outright grant as opposed to a repayable loan, the Kiwanis Club will welcome voluntary repayment of the awards, or any part thereof, in the future should the scholarship recipients so elect. Such action upon his/her part would assist the Bucyrus Kiwanis Club in making these particular academic school scholarships a permanent project so far as the Club is concerned.
