

The Byron Smith Memorial Scholarship

Description:

The Byron Smith Memorial Scholarship is named in honor of Byron D. Smith, a 1955 graduate of North Robinson High School. Byron was a farmer and life-long resident of the North Robinson/Colonel Crawford School District. Although he was not able to further his education after high school, he valued a college education and made sure his three daughters had the opportunity to receive a college degree. Through the generosity of many people, Byron's family was able to establish this scholarship so \$1,000.00 annually could be award to a graduate of Colonel Crawford High School, North Robinson, Ohio.

Requirements:

- Applicant must be a resident of the Colonel Crawford School District.
- Applicant must be either a graduating senior with minimum attendance of Junior and Senior years at Colonel Crawford High School, or a graduate of Colonel Crawford High School with minimum attendance of Junior and Senior years who is currently enrolled in a post-secondary institution pursuing a bachelor's degree.
- Applicant must have applied and been accepted to, or be enrolled in a four year accredited institution of higher education (college or university), pursuing a bachelor's degree. Applicants applying to or enrolled in an on-line college or university degree program will not be considered.
- Applicant may pursue a degree of study of his/her choice at the bachelor level.
- A current cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher is required of the applicant.
- Two (2) Letters of Recommendation are required, one letter from each of the following categories: 1) a current teacher/professor, or guidance counselor; 2) a coach, pastor, mentor, employer, co-curricular leader/advisor, or community service leader.
- Must submit approximately 300 word essay, typed, double-spaced explaining why the student is seeking this scholarship, how a bachelor's degree will improve or change his/her life, and why the student chose to attend the specific campus where he/she intends to enroll or is currently enrolled.
- Preference will be given to first-generation students.

Number of Awards:

1 annually

Award Amount:

\$1,000.00

Distribution of Award:

Scholarship will be paid directly to the college or university of the recipient after the completion of the Fall Semester following the receiving of the award.

Scholarship Selection Process:

A member(s) of the Byron Smith family and 1-2 current or retired teachers from Colonel Crawford School District will review applications and select the scholarship recipient.

2) ESSAY

Compose an essay answering the question below. Your essay should be approximately 300 words, typed, double-spaced on a separate page. Do not include your name on this page.

Explain why you are seeking this scholarship, how a bachelor's degree will improve or change your life, and why you chose to attend the specific campus where you are enrolled or intend to enroll.

3) LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

Two written letters of recommendation are required. Place in a sealed envelope. One letter of recommendation must be from each category: 1) a current teacher/professor or guidance counselor; 2) coach, pastor, mentor, employer, co-curricular leader/advisor, or community service leader.

4) TRANSCRIPT

A copy of your most recent high school or college transcript.
